October 12, 1919 - March 18, 2011

Welcome B. Singer, age 91, of Huntington, died at 4:35 a.m. Friday (March 18, 2011) at the Parkview Huntington Hospital.

Welcome was born October 12, 1919 in Mishawaka, Indiana, the son of Daniel and Gertrude (Austin) Singer. He attended Olivett College and went on to join the United States Army, serving in World War II. Welcome married Charlotte Snowden on April 9, 1939, in Huntington, and she survives.

Welcome owned Singer Garage Door Services, retiring after 27 years. He was a member of the First Church of the Nazarene and the V.F.W. Post #2689.

Survivors include his wife of 71 years - Charlotte Singer of Huntington; one daughter - Sharon Elaine (Gail) Hubartt of Battlefield, Missouri; one son - Kirk Alan (Vickie) Singer of Winnabow, North Carolina; two brothers - Charles (Robin) Singer of Deltona, Florida, and Lloyd (Helen) Singer of Kokomo; five grandchildren and four great-grandchildren. His parents, son - Terry Wayne Singer, brother - Richard Singer, and sisters - Zelpha Wilcox, and Audrey Pasko preceded him in death.
