



William A. "Bill" Clay

William A. "Bill" Clay, age 73, of Huntington, formerly of Warsaw and North Webster, died at 10:15 p.m. Saturday (January 23, 2016) at his home.

There will be no visitation or funeral services.

Bill was born on October 9, 1942 in Warsaw, the son of Cloice and Cleo (Parker) Clay. He graduated from Warsaw High School in 1961 and married Paula G. Hardin on February 16, 1974 in North Webster. Bill retired in 2000 from Bristol Myers (Zimmer) in Warsaw after 39 years of services. He was a member of American Legion Posts #223 of Syracuse, and formerly of Post #253 of North Webster, where he served as SAL Commander for two years.
