William E. "Bill" Mann, age 86, of Huntington, died at 4:30 a.m. Monday (July 30, 2012) at his home.

"Bill" was born in Huntington on February 6, 1926, the son of Kenneth and Keturah (Fox) Mann. "Bill" married Ethelind Joyce Keller on June 1, 1957 in Huntington. He graduated in 1944 Huntington.
