



## Willodean L. Kocher

December 31, 1926 - November 17, 2011

Willodean L. Kocher, age 84, of Huntington, died Thursday (November 17, 2011) at her home.

Willodean was born December 31, 1926, in Rockford Township, Huntington County, the daughter of Lyle and Hazel (Tribolet) Labertew. She graduated from Huntington High School in 1945. Willodean married Donald E. Kocher on June 19, 1949 in Huntington and he preceded her in death on May 22, 2008.

Mrs. Kocher retired in 1989 from Western & Southern Life Insurance Company where she worked in the Huntington office for over 18 years. Prior to that, she did clerical work for David Culp & Co. for 10 years. Willodean was a member of St. Peter's First Community Church, L & O Club, Thursday Evening Bunco Club and the Women's Circle at the church.

Willodean is survived by one son - Philip (Beverly) Kocher of Quincy, Ohio, one daughter - Barbara Seemeyer of Bloomington, three granddaughters - Allison Kocher, Jennifer Reeves and Jill Rogers and three great-grandchildren - Tyler Reeves, Taylor Rogers and Brian Rogers.
