Zona V. Harman, age 88, of Huntington, died at 2:40 p.m. Thursday (March 26, 2015) at Heritage Pointe in Warren.

Visitation will be 5 - 7 p.m. Monday (March 30, 2015) at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington. Funeral services will be at 11 a.m. Tuesday (March 31, 2015) at Bailey-Love Mortuary with Rev. Bob Land officiating. There will be one hour of visitation prior to the funeral service. Burial will be in Beech Grove Cemetery in Huntington County.

Zona was born December 9, 1926 in Clay County, Indiana, the daughter of Harry and Flossie (Rogers) Harmon. She graduated from high school in South Bend, Indiana in 1943 and received a degree in History and Education from Huntington (College) University in 1962. She married Willard J. Harman on December 8, 1943 in South Bend. He preceded her in death on October 13, 2014. She and her husband were sail boaters out of Michigan City, Indiana and did competitive sailboat racing for 34 years on Lake Michigan. They won numerous races and were overall winners of the Chicago to Mackinac Island sailboat race four times. She was a skilled seamstress and an accomplished needlepoint artist. Following their retirements, they spent winters in Key West,

Florida for 20 years, where she was active in the church ladies groups, the Key West Garden Club, and continued her needlepoint projects.

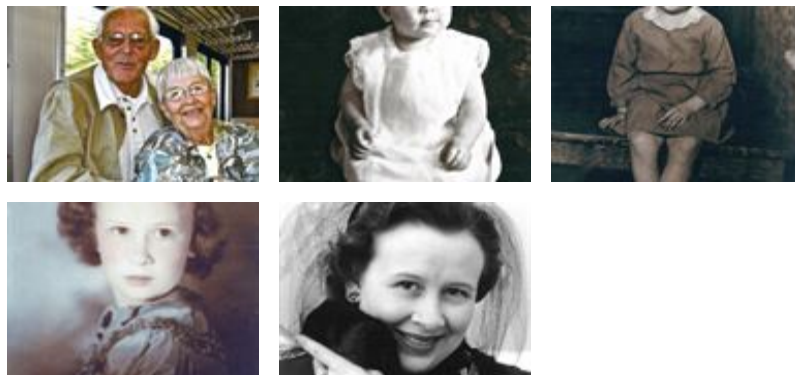
